The Department of Pediatrics of the University of British Columbia is currently accepting applications for fellowship positions in our Subspecialty Programs at the Department of Pediatrics for the 2024-2025 academic year.

About the Fellowships

The Department of Pediatrics, in collaboration with the University of British Columbia Postgraduate Medical Education office, offers Clinical Fellowship training for postgraduate medical trainees to undertake advanced clinical and research training at BC Children's Hospital. Fellowships range from 1 to 2 years with a maximum of 3 years. Two years are preferred for optimal fellowship experience. Please note that a clinical fellowship on its own is not a pathway to permanent practice as a specialist in Canada and clinical fellowship years alone do not count towards eligibility for Canadian licensure or Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) certification.

Why Here?

BC Children's Hospital (BCCH) is the only Children's Hospital in British Columbia, providing Tier 3 and 4 subspecialty medical care for one million children throughout the province and the Department of Pediatrics at the University of British Columbia offers Clinical fellowships through its 18 divisions. Sixteen subspecialty divisions are RCPSC-accredited training programs and each embraces a mandate of providing the best clinical care to all of BC's children and youth through a combination of BCCH-based services, outreach clinical, educational activities with expanded telehealth and e-health activities just around the corner.

Eligibility

Candidates must have:

- a medical degree
- a specialty diploma in pediatrics or currently enrolled in a Residency Training Program in Canada or elsewhere

- met all College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia (CPS-BC) requirements, including English language proficiency
- excellent clinical skills with demonstrated ability to work effectively with families in the care of children
- strong commitment to best practice and advancing knowledge in their field of practice
- strong inter-professional skills in working in complex environments;
 commitment to a clinical academic sub-specialty environment
